What is RWI?

Read Write Inc is not just a phonics programme. It has progression of fluency built in at every step.

We are equipping the children with a strategy to help decode any unfamiliar word.

Once they have this strategy, we then support them to build fluency with the sounds that they know.

Your child might be on the programme for a few weeks, a few months, or however long it takes, we are aiming for all children to see themselves as readers, confident with any text.

In the words of Dr. Seuss.....

Good readers do well in school- and in life.

By listening to your child read, you are making sure they have the opportunity to practise and become a good reader quickly.

Remember that all parents have power to change outcomes for their children

Read Write Inc. Phonics

- Children are taught in groups based on their phonics needs. These groups are fluid all year, children move in and out of them depending on the progress and specific needs.
- We assess the children every 6 weeks and depending on their phonics stage and fluency your child may change groups.

What is phonics?

Sounds

Graphemes

English alphabetic code

- 44 sounds
- 26 letters
- Over 150+ graphemes (letter combinations)

What can I do?

- 1.** Use pure sounds, not letter names
- 2.** Use Fred Talk to read and spell words.
Follow the sequence:
 - ❖ Special/Best friends
 - ❖ Fred Talk/Sound talk
 - ❖ Read the word
- 3.** Listen to your child read their Storybook every day
- 4.** Read stories to your child every day

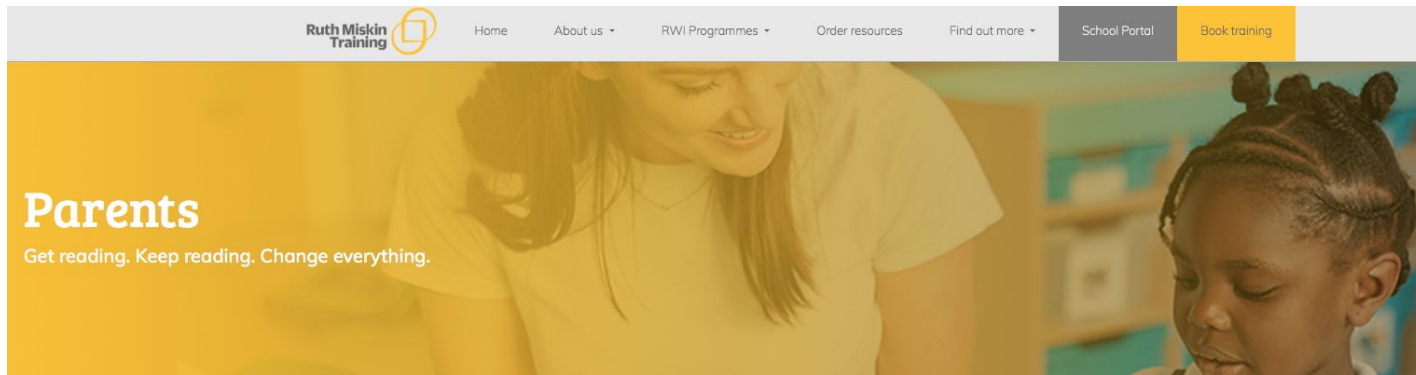
Teach spelling using Fred Fingers

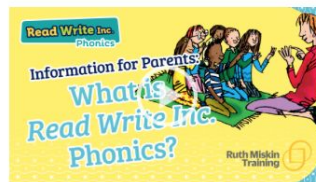


Read Write Inc. Phonics – information for parents
